We continue a short distance to Mossman Gorge Cultural Centre: Here you are greeted with a traditional smoking ceremony. This ceremony is conducted by Aboriginal people with specialised cultural knowledge to welcome people to their land. Enjoy a delicious lunch infused with the local flavours, served in the Mossman Gorge Centre at the edge of the rainforest. Wander into the lush rainforest of the World Heritage Listed Daintree National Park - Mossman Gorge. An easy walk across boardwalks, tracks and bridges that protect the delicate ecosystem that adorns spectacular waterfalls and mountain ranges.

Your guide will explain the rich flora, fauna and diverse ecosystem of this amazing rainforest. We are privileged to be given access to an area of Mossman Gorge that most are not usually allowed to go. Ensure you bring your bathers so you are able to make the most of the beautiful private swimming hole that is encased by rainforest. 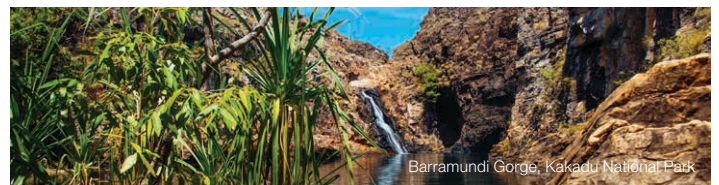

DAY 1: ARRIVE PERTH
